

FAULK MIDDLE SCHOOL Parent Reminders

1. Students are expected to show up to school on time every day. Breakfast in the classroom begins at 7:25 and ends at 7:40 AM. Student arriving after this time are considered tardy and will be subject to tardy policy consequences and further administrative action listed in SCOC.
2. We believe that communication is crucial. Please come by the school to check that your address and phone numbers are correct. Changes can only be made in person and proof of address is required in case a change is needed. We must be able to reach you at any time. Our personnel and school messenger will only call the numbers available on our system.
3. Students will NOT be released after 2:30 p.m. for non-emergencies. Please plan ahead.
4. Students' birthdays will be held ONLY on Fridays during the last 15 minutes of the day. Please contact your child's 9th period teacher to make arrangements if you wish to do a celebration in the classroom. Floral arrangements, balloons, and presents delivered to office will be given to student at the end of the school day. Food delivered to office can only be consumed by student during assigned lunch time or at scheduled birthday celebration.
5. Weekly Parent Meetings are held every Thursday @9:00 A.M. at our Parent Center. We invite you to become part of our team and get involved in your child's education!
6. Our attendance goal is 98% for the year, so we ask that you please schedule medical and personal appointments after school hours or weekends. In case your student needs to miss school, please send us the written medical or parental excuse the following day.
7. Our STAAR goal this year is to surpass 90% in all tested areas. Please help us by monitoring your child's weekly grades and encouraging your child to attend tutorial sessions. Ask us about getting access to HAC (Home Access Center).
8. Our campus follows a strict dress code. Please have your child follow it every day. If you need to purchase a uniform please contact our school. All sales are final. More details are posted on our school website.
9. The use of electronic devices such as cellphones, etc is not a necessity but a privilege. A student does not have the right to use electronic devices during instructional hours for personal matters. These will be confiscated and the privilege to carry them will be taken away if student does not comply.
10. In an effort to provide academic and personal support, we follow a team concept in each grade level. A team of teachers will be closely monitoring your child's attendance, grades, and discipline. Regular in person or phone conferences will be scheduled to address any concerns.
